BALLOT MEASURES

- YES **PROP 133** REQUIRES PARTISAN PRIMARIES AND PROHIBITS "OPEN PRIMARIES"
- YES **PROP 134** SIGNATURE DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT FOR INITIATIVES
- NO **PROP 135** GIVES GOVERNOR 30-DAY CONSTITUTIONAL EMERGENCY POWERS WITHOUT LIMITATION
- YES **PROP 136** LEGAL CHALLENGES TO CONSTITUTIONALITY OF INITIATIVES
- NO **PROP 137** A YES VOTE WOULD ELIMINATE TERM LIMITS FOR JUDGES
- NO **PROP 138** ALLOWS EMPLOYERS TO LOWER WAGES UP TO 25% FOR TIPPED WORKERS
